



WHAT TO EXPECT ON YOUR TRIAL LESSON

There is no feeling quite like taking control of an aircraft for the very first time and it is an experience everyone should have - at least once in their lifetime.

On the day of your flight, please ensure you arrive in plenty of time and present your voucher at the flying school reception. Your instructor will then brief you about the details of the flight, including the intended route and departure phase.

Once at the aircraft you will be shown the 'walk around': a visual examination of the aircraft, performed before each flight. On entering the cockpit the layout of instrumentation and controls will be explained.

When airborne you will – under the expert tuition of your instructor - be able to experience taking control, practice climbing, descending and turning.

On a clear day you may expect to have fantastic views, however flying is very weather dependant and certain conditions will affect the experience. The visibility (measured in kilometres) will determine how far you can see when airborne. The images below show comparisons between poor and excellent visibility.

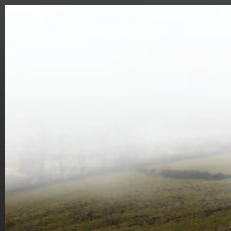
Other than visibility; cloud base, wind speed and rain are also factors which will affect your flight. It is therefore important to telephone Multiflight on the day of your flight in order to check the weather at the airport, even if it appears to be a perfect day for flying.

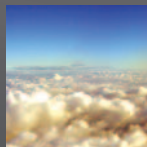
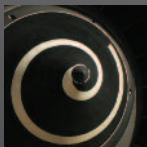
5km Visibility
