Private Pilot's Licence Helicopters, PPL(H)

At Multiflight you can expect to find your training challenging and a lot of fun, with rewards that are real and tangible. Gaining your own Private Pilot's Licence (Helicopter) is a real personal achievement. We take pride in tailoring courses and the style of tuition to suit your requirements and your timetable. In the UK in order to obtain the basic flying licence for helicopters, PPL(H), it is necessary to undergo a course of a minimum of 45 hours flying. During your training you will learn how to control the aircraft in the air; how to taxi; how to take-off, fly a circuit, hover and land the helicopter. This includes a minimum of 10 hours as Pilot-in-Command and five hours instrument appreciation. You must also pass a flying test and a number of ground examinations. As you progress and build your flying hours with dual instruction exercises the first milestone in any pilot's flying career is the 'First Solo'. This is usually attained after approximately 20 hours of instruction. This flight normally lasts about 10 minutes and includes a take-off, a circuit of the airfield and a landing. But as you will be entirely on your own for the first time you will probably remember the elation and sense of achievement from this flight for the rest of your life! You are now awell on your way to achieving your dream of becoming a helicopter pilot.

Additional Qualifications

Having gained your PPL(H) in either the Robinson R22 or the Robinson R44, to take full advantage of available flying time you could consider obtaining a night rating. Multiflight also specialise in type rating conversion training which allows the PPL(H) holder to fly the larger helicopters such as the Robinson R44, Jet Ranger, Single or Twin Squirrel and Dauphin.

Helicopter Commercial Licence, CPL (H)

Anyone looking to fly a helicopter for remuneration needs to hold a Commercial Pilot's Licence (Helicopters). The CPL(H) is the professional licence that allows the holder to work as a helicopter pilot and perhaps to work with a charter fleet, such as Multiflight's helicopter charter fleet, to fly a helicopter with the oil industry, or to get a job as

an instructor if you do a Flying Instructor Rating.

The CPL(H) can be undertaken either as an Integrated or as a Modular course. Here at Multiflight we are approved to run Modular helicopter flying training courses. We are perfectly positioned for commercial pilot helicopter training, as we are located at an international airport and so you will get used to flying in and out of controlled airspace while doing your training with us.

There are minimum course requirements that you must meet in full to start your CPL(H) training. These include a total of 155 helicopter flying hours: this must include 50 Pilot in Command flying hours; a valid JAR Class 1 medical, and you must also have completed and passed all theoretical knowledge exams.

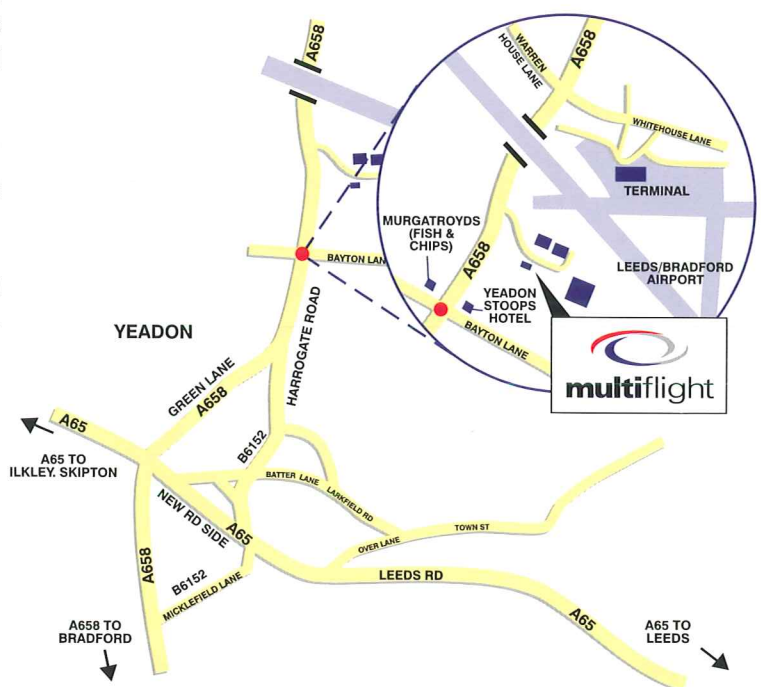
Hire or Purchase Your Own Helicopter

Once you have gained your PPL(H) licence you may hire the Robinson and Jetranger helicopters from Multiflight. You can also purchase before, during or after your training, in which case Multiflight can advise and assist in all aspects including helicopter management, hangarage and maintenance.

Trial Helicopter Flying Lesson

The first step in achieving your ambition to gain a PPL(H) is a trial lesson in a Robinson R22 or Robinson R44 helicopter and includes a detailed pre-flight ground briefing and one hour or half an hour of flying time.
